# Nearly 50 Years of Adventure and Learning



Every day at Apple Montessori Camp is a carousel of learning adventures.

Every 40 minutes, campers rotate through an age-specific curriculum that includes programs like Junior Scientists, Creative Kids, Tech Time, Shining Stars and Young Chefs. Most of the camps also have four levels of swimming taught daily.

“Apple’s Summer Camp program is a well-established, well-rounded and reputable program that children love,” says Joanne Mooney, whose family founded Apple Montessori in 1972.

That’s Apple Camp in a nutshell: kids who love what they’re doing under the eyes of year-round, professional teachers who love what they do, too.

### SUMMER EDUCATION THE FUN WAY

Apple Camp also embraces the educational current that already runs through Apple Montessori’s curriculum.

“Children don’t stop loving to learn because it’s summer,” Mooney says.

Apple camps feature traditional summer activities, including arts and crafts, music, cooking, dance and nature and science. There’s also a proven reading program, computers and exposure to a STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) curriculum.

It “helps to avoid the summer slump in terms of learning with our students,” Mooney says. “Montessori is very much a hands-on approach to learning. Children are able to progress at their own level and at their own pace. Our curriculum is designed around the individual child and where they are academically.”

### FLEXIBLE FOR OUR FAMILIES

Apple Montessori School has run schools and camps for more than 45 years with 15



locations in urban and suburban settings throughout Central and North Jersey. Campers range in age from 2-12 years old.

Camps are open a total of eight weeks with a three-week minimum (there are also half-day schedules). Full-day schedules offer before- and after-care. Hours start as early as 7 am and run as late as 7 pm in several locations.

“We very much want to be flexible for our families,” Mooney says. “Many of our families

go on summer holidays or vacations. This way, we can help families ensure their children get the most out of summer.”

Another high point for Apple Montessori is its focus on safety. Mooney is proud of front-door security systems, swipe cards individualized to families and cameras that allow parents to remotely monitor activity. “The parents love the cameras,” Mooney says. “It helps them feel very connected to what their child is doing during the day.
